All accompanying bags must be clearly marked with quilters name, quilt title and phone number.

Quilts can be delivered to Apple Tree Crafts from Sat 20<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to Fri 2<sup>nd</sup> June and must be collected from there by 17<sup>th</sup> June. Failure to collect quilt will be taken as permission to donate the quilt to a worthy charity!!!!
