Rules of Entry

- Quilted/Patchwork items are welcome – **no limit for quilts or smaller items** e.g. bags, cushions, wall-hangings etc.
- Unfinished quilts/items are also welcome to be entered into the exhibition.
- We request that completed quilts have a **hanging sleeve** of at least 4½” deep **must** be attached securely to the back of your quilt. This does not apply to unfinished quilts/items.
- All quilts/items **must** have a label, with name, on the back for easy identification.
- Entries **must** have an accompanying cloth bag which is clearly marked with your **Name and Telephone Number**.
- If there are any specific or unusual hanging requirements a hanging plan (diagram) **must** be included inside the packaging with your quilt.
- We endeavour to hang all pieces which comply with the “Rules of Entry” where we receive an entry form by the due date, but this cannot be guaranteed and the Wicklow Patchwork Group Subcommittee reserves the right not to display any piece for whatever reason.

Sale of Entries - Items on display may be offered for sale at the exhibition. If your quilt/item is for sale please indicate the selling price. We will put interested parties in contact with the quilter but will not get involved with the negotiations.

Some of the quilts will be in a position where visitors will be able to touch and examine the quilts; this is so non-quilters can see how they are made and quilters can see different techniques close up. **(Please circle your response)**

No responsibility can be taken for items not collected at this time. If you are not in position to collect your quilt/entries at this time, please arrange for somebody else to do so.
