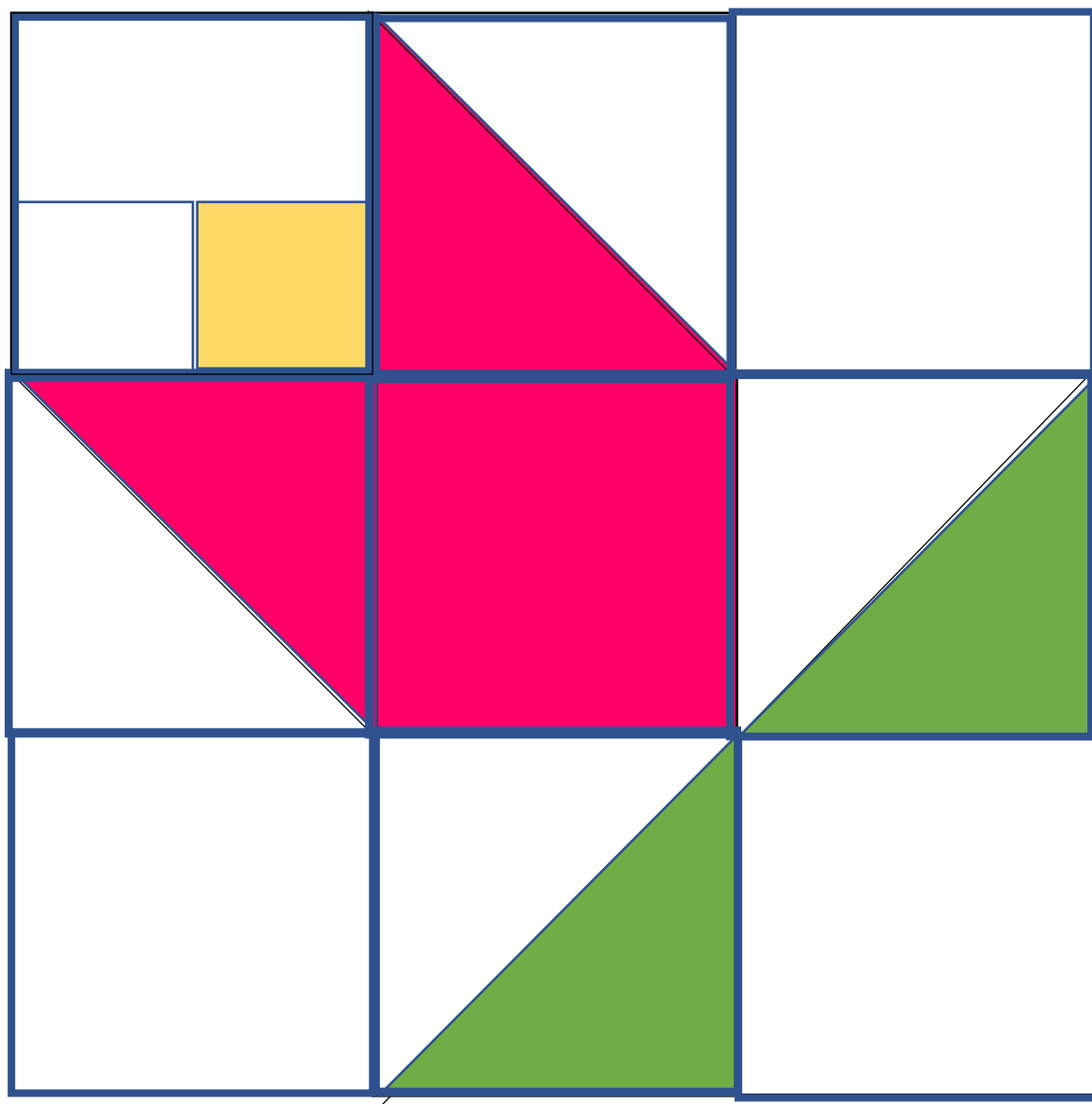


# WPG 2020 Collaborative Quilt

## Flower – Pinwheel Block Pattern



## Flower Block

It consists of 9 smaller blocks.

### Cutting for pieces:

Background white:

1 1.5"x1.5"

1 1.5"x2.5"

3 2.5" x 2.5"

2 3" x 3"

Petal Fabric:

1 2.5"x2.5"

1 3" x 3"

Leaf Fabric:

1 3" x 3"

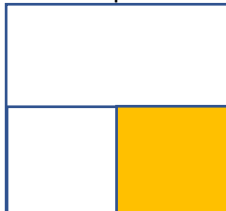
Flower Centre Yellow

1 1.5" x 1.5"

### Construction

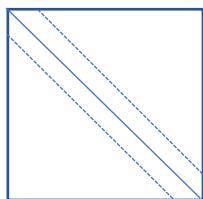
Sew 1.5" white square to yellow square. Press to colour.

Sew this patch to 1.5 x2.5" white piece.



Mark the diagonal line on the 3" white squares.

Place petal 3" square right sides together with white 3" square. Sew quarter inch from marked line on both sides. Cut along line to create 2 half square triangles. Press to colour. Cut to 2.5" square ensuring 45 degree angle.



Make two more half square triangles from leaf fabric and white.

All 9 small blocks must measure 2.5" square. Sew 9 small blocks as in diagram.

Make sure finished block measures 6.5" square.

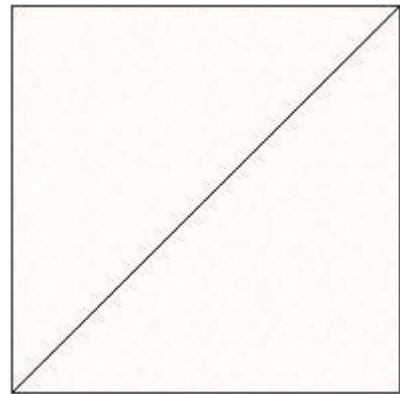
## Basic Pinwheel

The basic Pinwheel block is simply four half square triangles sets put together in a four patch block. To make one 6 1/2 inch (6 inch finished in the quilt) basic Pinwheel block you need two 3 7/8 inch squares of a light color (white) and two 3 7/8 inch squares of a darker color (red). You may cut these 4 inches square to make slightly larger and cut back each half square triangles set to 3.5 inches.

Here are step by step directions to make two triangle squares.

Carefully draw a line corner to corner, (diagonally) through the white or lightest 3 7/8 inch squares. This will be a cutting line when you are finished.

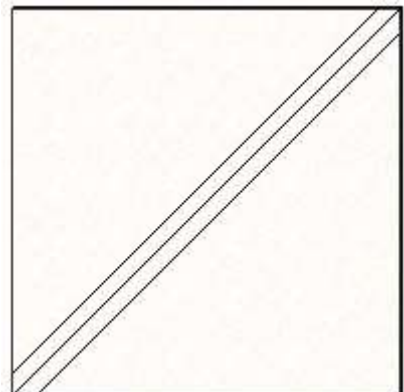


Place coloured and white 3 7/8 inch square right sides together.

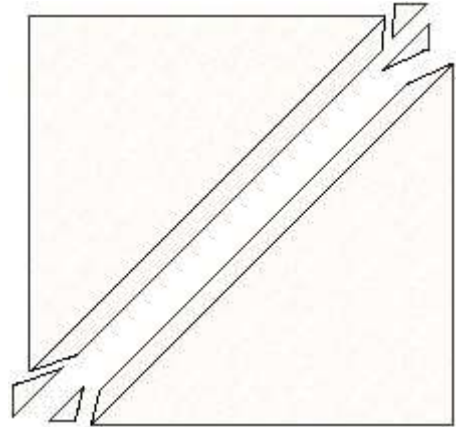


If you have a true 1/4 inch foot on your machine, you can sew on either side of the drawn line.

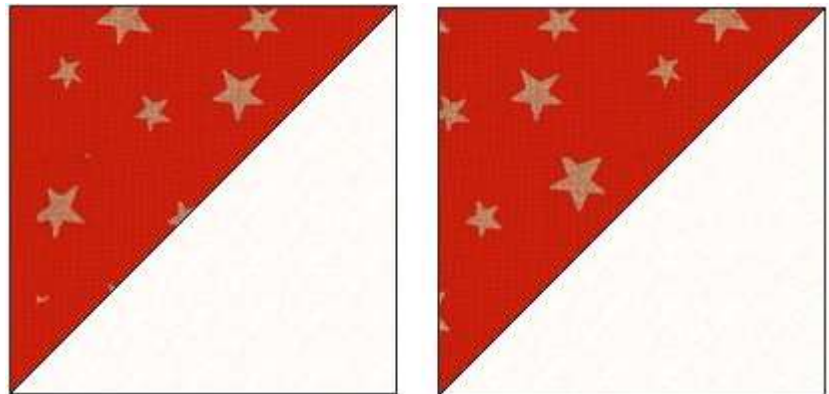
If not, you will have to draw a second line on either side, exactly 1/4 inch from the first line. Those will be your sewing lines.



After you have sewn on the sewing lines (1/4 inch on either side of your corner to corner to line) you will cut this square in half on the drawn cutting line. Clip off the corners as shown.



You will now have two triangle squares, which should measure exactly 3 1/2 inches. You need four triangle squares for one Pinwheel block, so repeat the same steps.



Sew them together into pairs which look like this, and then sew the two together to finish your Pinwheel block. This block should measure 6 1/2 inches.

To make any size half square triangle: Add 7/8 inch to the required finished size and cut squares of that size. E.g. Finished 12 inch block cut 12 7/8 square.
