

Tiny House Block

For the roof:

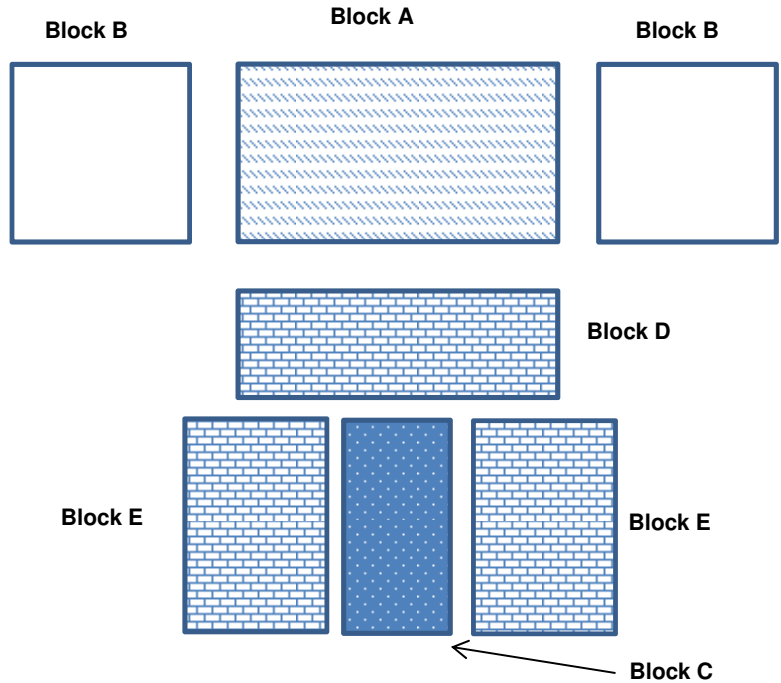
- A. Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- B. Cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

For the door:

- C. Cut one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"

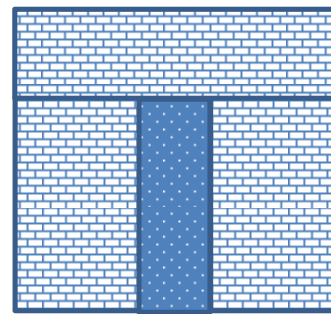
For the house, from the same fabric

- D. Cut one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- E. Cut two 2" x 3" for sides



Sew the house sides (E) to either side of the door (C).

Then sew the top of the house (D) to the two sides and door.

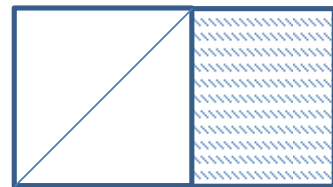


Make the roof like flying geese or snowball corners

Sew diagonally across the first $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Trim before sewing second side.

Sew diagonally across the second $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Sew roof to house.

Your block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6"
